

Adding Useful Links for your Readers



WEBSITE LINKS are a great way to re-direct your visitors to other useful websites. The website links could be to display your associated organisations, interesting sites or further information on topics that relate to your organisation.

To set up this function, select **WEBSITE LINKS** on the left side menu to reveal a dropdown that contains Options, Link Types and Links.

Begin by selecting **OPTIONS** in the left side menu.

Click **EDIT** and change **MENU DISPLAY** to **YES** and creating a **TITLE** for the page, e.g. 'links' or 'useful websites'.

If you would like to categorise your links, select **LINK TYPES**.

Click **ADD**, provide a **TITLE** for each category and set **PUBLIC DISPLAY** to **YES**.

Click on **LINK TYPES** in the left hand menu again and set each **STATUS** to a **GREEN TICK**.

Now click on **LINKS** in the left hand menu to add your individual links.

Click the **ADD** button.

Select the **LINK TYPE** if you created these, otherwise leave it as it is.

Enter a **TITLE** and the links **URL**. You can set the order that the links appear in by entering numbers under **ORDER**.

Click the **SAVE** button.

Lastly, click on **SPONSORS** again in the left side menu and set the **STATUS** of each sponsor to a **GREEN TICK**.
