

# Step 4: Website Settings



**Quick Steps: Website > Front End Website > Website Settings > Save**

1. Login to the SportsTG console at <https://console.sportstg.com/>

2. Click on **Website**, then click on the *House* icon

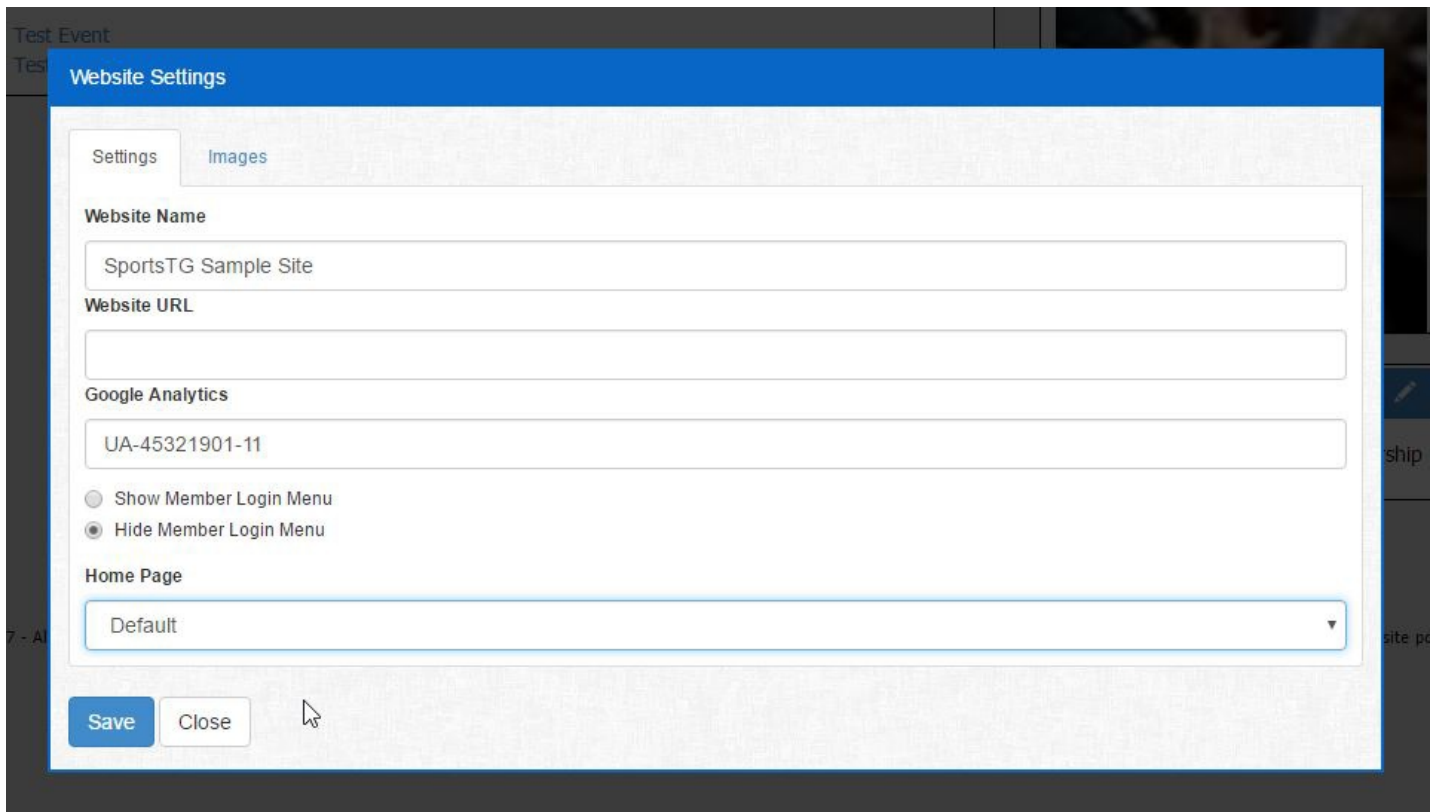
