


Setting Up Pagination

Quick Steps: Shop > Shop Settings > Options > Design

Pagination allows you to control how many products display on a single page within your online store.

1. Within the Management Console, select **Shop** from the top menu, then **Shop Settings** from the left menu.
2. Select **Options** from the expanded left menu.
3. Click **Edit** then go to the **Design** tab.
4. Set **Pagination** to Yes, then select the amount of items per page that you would like on your online store between 1 and 50.
