

# Events Member Email Merge Fields

Events now allow Event Administrators the ability to include all member email merge fields within an email sent to event entrants.

This allows administrators the ability to include their members' information in emails sent to Event Entrants, including Custom Fields, Member Number and Financial End Date. This is most useful for Member Only events to help in confirming member details.
