



• Add title, description, images, featured image, select category - all things you do when adding a regular product





Step 2:

- Complete the AUCTION product data

 - Reserve Price = The amount the auction must reach to allow the item to be sold
 - Buy it now Price = The price you set for ONE consumer to purchase the product outright and end the auction (optional)
