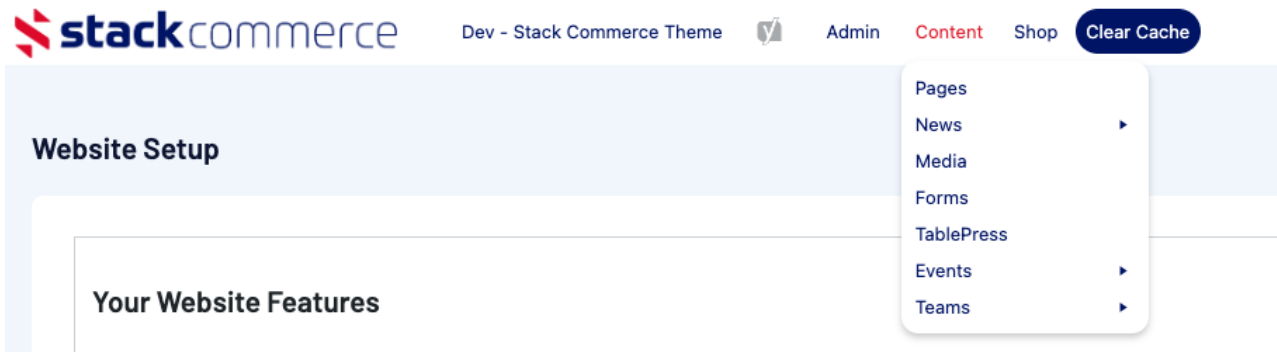


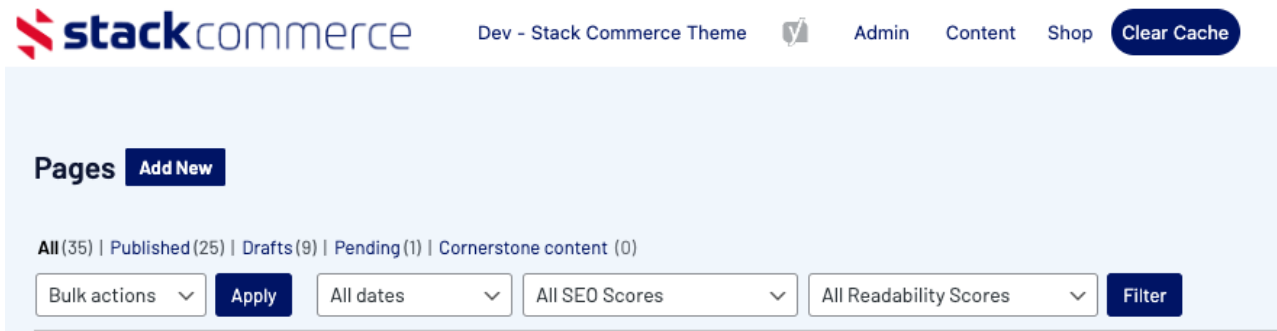
Creating a blank / default page


1. Hover over **CONTENT**.
2. Click on **PAGES**.



3. Click **ADD NEW** against the PAGES heading.



4. On the right hand side of the page you will see a **PAGE ATTRIBUTES** menu. Under this menu, select the **Default Template** from the **TEMPLATE** drop down list.

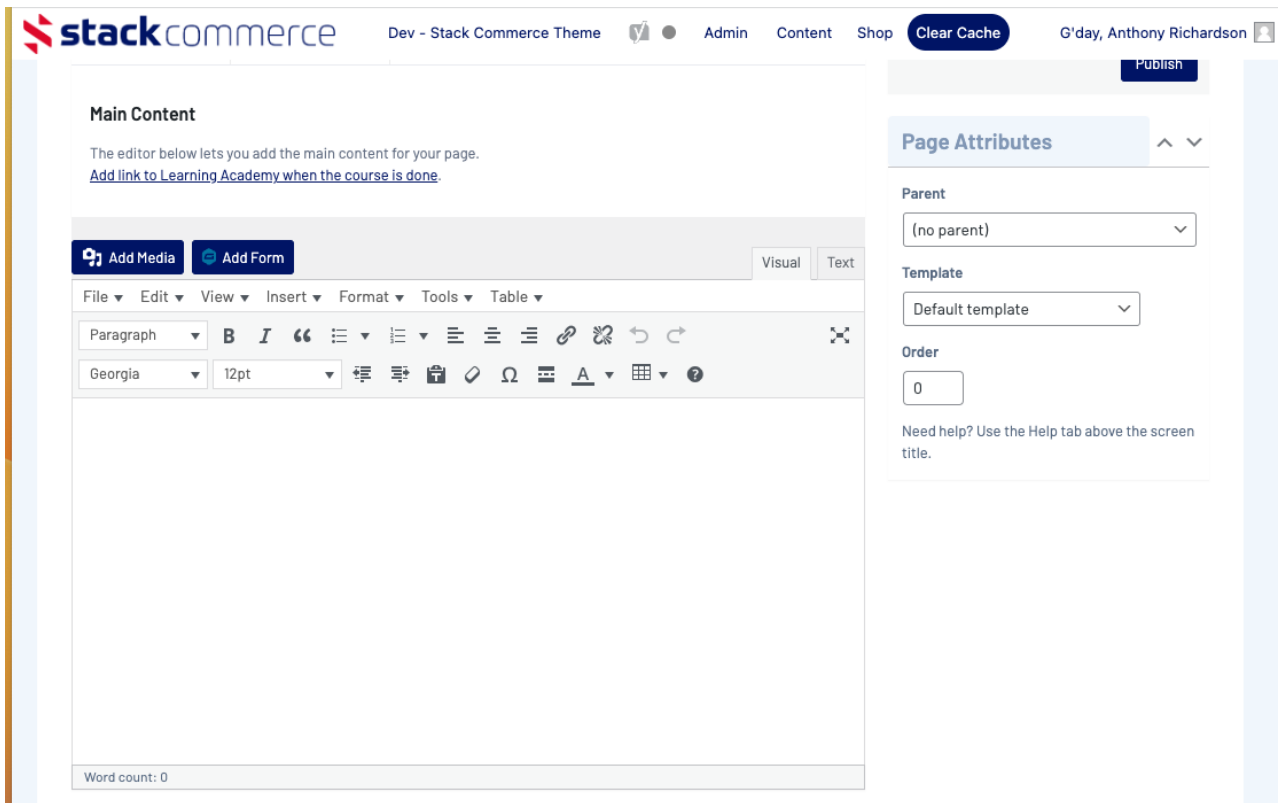

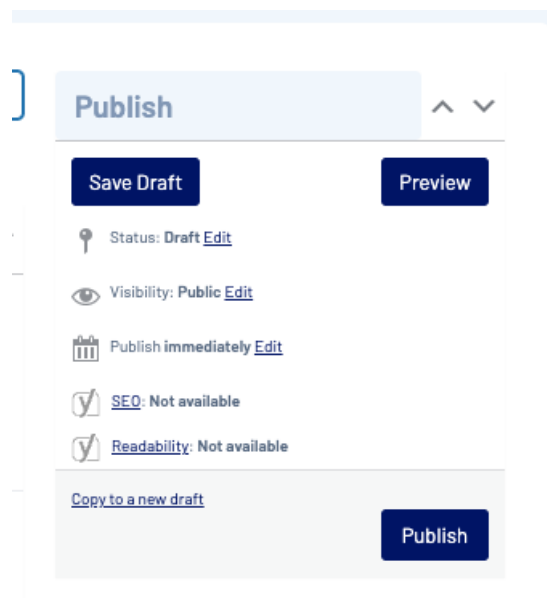
6. Select any additional sections you would like to display below the custom content of the page.
