

# Creating a Team Page

The team page was referred to as the player list page in the previous theme. This page is a little different than the old theme as this page displays the players within each team rather than just the players in general.

**NOTE:** the team page can only be created if the **PLAYER LIST PAGE ADD ON** is enabled for your organisation. To check if this is available for your website, [check your website Dashboard](#).

**NOTE:** teams need to be created and players need to be added and assigned to teams before this page will display correctly.


1. Hover over **CONTENT**.
2. Click on **PAGES**.



3. Click **ADD NEW** against the PAGES heading.



4. On the right hand side of the page you will see a **PAGE ATTRIBUTES** menu. Under this menu, select the **TEAM PAGE** from the **TEMPLATE** drop down list.


